Members are asked to continue collecting pull tabs from their used aluminum cans for donation to a program at UC Davis Medical Center that recycles pull tabs to raise funds.

Proceeds from the effort support the Adopt-A-Family Program, which helps subsidize lodging costs at the Ronald McDonald House.

Parents traveling from outside the Sacramento area so their children can undergo medical treatment at UC Davis Medical Center can stay at the Ronald McDonald House during their children's treatment.

In December, board member Ron Cristoni dropped off our donations to the Ronald McDonald House.

When he asked the receptionist how much parents are charged to spend a night there, she answered: "\$20 a night, if they can afford it."

We have delivered a total of 1,025 pounds of pull tabs since we started donating to the program.

So if the Ronald McDonald House receives \$1 per pound of pull tabs, our club members have donated 51 nights of lodging for out-of-town parents.

A big hand to all! Thank you, and please continue to donate.




Also, if you know members who would like to make financial donations to help the club, please let me know. I am happy to discuss this with them.
